

The rich experience of on-campus learning, research, athletics and camaraderie depends on you.






#### MU'S COVID-19 TESTING

#### MU Health Care:

- 650 Physicians
- 1,300 Nurses
- Up to 400 beds for COVID patients can be made available
- In-house testing capabilities of 1,500 samples per day (plan is to increase to 3,000/day by September)

#### There will two drive-through sites for testing:

- MU softball field (2 lanes)
- Mizzou North (2 lanes)
- Results within 24 to 72 hours





#### # M A S K U P M I Z Z O U

City of Columbia voted to require face coverings in public:


#### Face coverings required:

In most situations on campus - in class, in campus buildings, hallways

#### Do not need face covering when:

- You are alone in a private workspace
- You are outdoors and able to keep 6 feet distance from others

Instructors will wear a face shield when teaching and will have 6 feet distance from students



#### LECTURE HALL CHANGES






#### MODIFIED COMMON AREAS
